UHF TRANSMISSIONS COME TO THE EAST COAST

Changes to radio and television generally in Tasmania will take place in the near future, some within the next few weeks.

For listeners and viewers on the East coast the following will occur between now and the end of May and will be advertised throughout the media with further details.

RADIO

Regional Radio - will commence broadcasting "on air" services from St Helens on 15 April and from St Marys on 16 May.

Radio National - will commence from both St Marys and St Helens on 29 April. Test broadcasting from these sites will commence some weeks before hand.

TELEVISION

ABC will change to UHF and will transmit from the following sites on 16 March.

St Marys)Existing = VHF Chan 1
"South Sister")Change to = UHF Chan 56
Antenna must be vertical

St Helens)Existing = VHF Chan 0
"Parnella")Change to = Chan 31
Antenna must be horizontal

Test transmission commenced from this site on 28 February.

Binalong Bay)New Translator
"Gardens Road")UHF 33
Antenna must be vertical

TELEVISION COMMERCIAL

TNT - Southern Cross will continue to transmit on VHF Channel 11 at St Marys and Channel 7 at St Helens until a change to UHF channels expected in the near future.

TVT - Will commence broadcasting with Test Pattern on 1 April and programme on 30 April from the following sites.

St Marys)New Translator
"South Sister")UHF Chan 62
Antenna must be vertical

St Helens)New Translator
"Parnella")UHF Chan 40
Antenna must be vertical

Binalong Bay)UHF Chan 42
"Gardens Road")
Antenna must be vertical.

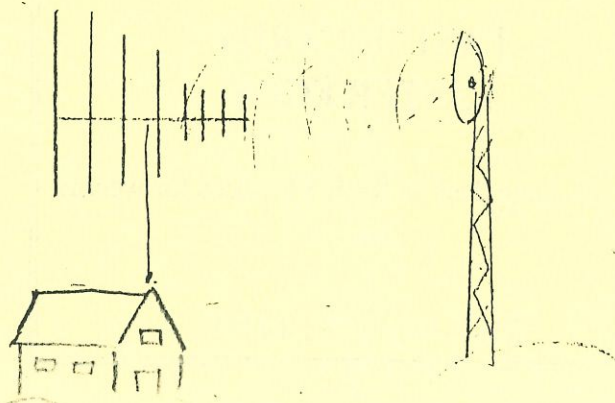
(This translator will commence in October 94)

Notes:

- 1 It may be advisable for viewers to leave any anticipated changes to antennas until after transmission commences in order to gain knowledge of signal strengths etc and thus determine actual need. Whilst CO-AX cable will be necessary, antenna type may vary.
- 2 Older TV sets with no provision for UHF channels will in most cases work perfectly well with a VIDEO for reception of new UHF channels.

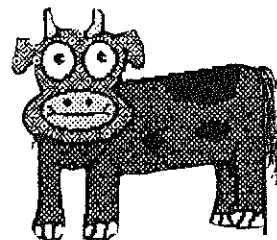
Did you know that ACIS has a video lending library? The video's - which are free - cover a wide range of general interest topics including:

A FAST BUCK?

Is there some enterprising person out there with time on his or her hands who would like to make themselves a cool \$800? If so the CSIRO urgently needs eight (8) live healthy hares, for which they are willing to pay the catcher \$100 each. The age of the animals does not matter; leverets will do so long as they are weaned. Adults, if they can be caught, are also OK.

The important thing is that there must be a total of eight, so the catcher/s may need to keep and feed them in a temporary enclosure for a short while until that number is captured. It is also a pre-requisite that formal permission be obtained from any landowner whose property might be involved in the hunt. Trespassing, for any reason, is against the law.

As well as \$100 per hare, CSIRO will also pay whatever expenses are involved in delivering the animals safely to their eventual destination. For more details contact Tim McManus, DPI&F Veterinary Extension Officer, on 725143.

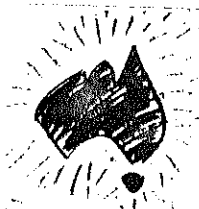
